The Child Care Aide provides care for children infant to school-age in the YWCA St. Paul Transitional Housing Program drop-in childcare program. In this role you will:

- Prepare and lead group activities with children including arts and crafts, games, music, and other recreational activities.
- Focus on social-emotional skill development for children, creating a safe, positive, fun environment and modeling positive behaviors for children and their families.
- Assist with orientation of new children and health history checks.
- Maintain cleanliness of program space and assist with room set-up.
- Assist with field trip preparation and activities.
- Assist with scheduling, attendance and other administrative duties.

The successful applicant will have:

- Minimum of one year of experience working with children in a group setting.
- Commitment and ability to work with diverse populations.
- Ability to work with children of all ages including infants.
